

Scholarship Award Program

Criteria for Selection:

The selection committee will evaluate each applicant according to the criteria established by the SVICA. Subject to the number of applications received, priority will be given to applicants who are indentured or enrolled in a trade related program and pursuing an educational program that would likely involve full time employment in the construction industry. All scholarship/bursary awards will be formally announced and presented at the annual general meeting of the Construction Association. The deadline for entries is January 4th. Successful candidates will be notified by Mid January and must attend the Annual General Meeting.

Background

Sponsored by the Construction Association, the award program offers funding to dependents of SVICA members, and employees of member companies in good standing. The purpose of the program is to recognize individuals who demonstrate a desire to continue to improve their education and further their careers. The program has been established to offer support for those interested in expanding their personal industry education and knowledge base. The award is primarily based on academic standing and work history, with consideration given to other achievements and circumstances.

Eligibility

All candidates must be a member in good standing of SVICA, their immediate families and/or employees of SVICA member companies (immediate family is defined as self, spouse or child.) Qualifying as one of the following:

- High school students, undergraduate or graduate students or*
- Technical trade school students, or*
- Provisionally accepted as students into undergraduate or graduate degree programs for the coming academic year by accredited colleges, universities or trade schools.*

Entry Requirements

The following data is required from each candidate:

- An official application form. Copies are not accepted.*
- An official transcript of all high school, college or university records. (As applicable)*
- An official transcript of all technical or trade school records. (As applicable)*
- A letter from the college, university or trade school where the undergraduate or graduate work will be undertaken, indicating provisional acceptance of the proposed course of study.*
- Nomination letter from a SVICA employer.*
